 - Are designated as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization
 - Operate in one of the following markets: Southern Tier, NY; Franklin County, PA; or Wilmington/Leland, NC
- Efforts will be made to contribute to organizations that can provide documentation that measure and evaluate their programs.
