- ▶ A completed and signed W-9
- ▶ Proof of enrollment or acceptance (college or trade school bill, course schedule, etc.)
- ▶ A copy of your government issued identification

Please only send the above if selected for a scholarship. All required information must be received by SAFE by June 15th.
